We Ensure Outreach: We are very mindful that we are a well-resourced parish. We aim to give 10% of our income away to our mission partners. Our outreach takes many forms and reaches in-need parishes, individuals, families, and organizations.

We Empower Our Diocese: As Episcopalians we belong not just to the San Diego Diocese, but also to the worldwide Anglican communion. This is represented in our giving by the requirement that 10.5% of our income goes to the Diocese. “ Supporting our diocese is another form of outreach.
